**BOOK SIGNING: DR. SUSAN HOWELL**

On May 15th following worship, Dr. Susan Howell will be signing a new book she recently wrote entitled *Buried Talents: Overcoming Gendered Socialization to Answer God's Call*. Further details will be coming soon, but please mark your calendars. Dr. Howell teaches at Campbellsville University and she and her husband Dwayne regularly attend events, classes, and worship at CHBC. What follows is a brief description of the book.

**“If God is calling women to lead, what's holding them back?** Susan Harris Howell has spent years helping students investigate this question. In *Buried Talents*, she makes clear how gender disparity in leadership is directly connected to a larger, less overt issue: gendered socialization. Howell examines gendered messages people encounter inside and outside the church in each stage of life, showing how they often create misconceptions about who women are, what they're capable of, and how they fit into God's work.”

#### **PRAYER IN CHRISTIAN HISTORY: AN ECUMENICAL APPROACH**
