Voting Instructions

The called Ministry Forum will begin immediately following the service. If you are a guest or choosing not to vote today, you are invited to leave at the conclusion of the service. We ask those who are staying for the Ministry Forum to remain in their seats so we can begin quickly. The Zoom meeting will run parallel, but separately to the in-person meeting. Each meeting will open with prayer, followed by the reading of the motion by a member of the Church Council, a brief time of discussion for or against the motion, and then the vote will be taken. Once the ballots are collected, members of the Church Council will count the vote, and the results will be announced. The Ministry Forum will conclude with a word of prayer.
