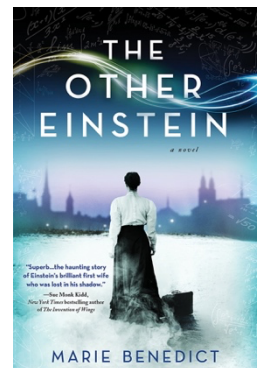


Guns to Gardens
