Centralized Food Pantry

We have two food pantries we help regularly. We have been long time supporters of United Crescent Hill Ministry’s (UCHM) food pantry, and in the last 3 years, the Mission Response Team has begun a Little Free Pantry (LFP) on our property near the Library Parking Lot. In an effort to streamline our donations and emphasize these ministry opportunities, we will focus on collecting donations on the 3rd Sunday of each month. There will be a bin in Birchwood Lobby on the 3rd Sunday of the month, beginning on **March 19** where you can drop off non-perishable food items (canned foods, boxed goods, rice, beans, cooking oil, soup, etc.), hygiene items (diapers, wipes, feminine pads and tampons, soap, shampoo, etc.), or basic household items (dish soap, laundry detergent, etc.). These items will be split between UCHM and the LFP. If you would like a donated item to go specifically to UCHM or LFP, simply label the item, and we will make sure it goes to its intended place.
